

# Alberta Health Care Aide Provincial Examination Results Academic Year (July 1 – June 30)



## ***Provincial HCA Exam Development***

The [Provincial HCA Exam Blueprint](#) provides an overview of the structure of the exam in relation to the competency profile and is available on the [HCA Directory Website](#). A panel of subject matter experts (SMEs) participated in the development of the blueprint and all HCA Exams.

To ensure fairness and testing of minimal competencies required to practice as an Alberta HCA, all development adheres to psychometric principles: reliability, validity, standardization, and freedom from bias or sensitivity.

There are 100 multiple choice questions on each exam and the number of correct answers required to pass may vary from one exam to the next. The passing score for each exam is developed by an expert panel and is based on the difficulty of the questions included in the exam. However, the level of ability required to pass (minimal competence) remains the same for each exam. Candidates are allowed up to 3 attempts to pass the exam.

## ***Provincial HCA Exam Statistics***

The Alberta HCA Directory publishes the statistics for first time writers of the Provincial HCA Exam for each of the Post Secondary Institutions (PSIs) licensed to deliver the provincial HCA curriculum, as aligned to the HCA program licensing standards. This informs students, PSIs, and other stakeholders of the passing rates for each PSI as compared with the provincial average.

The numbers in the following chart represent success rates for first-time writers from Alberta HCA programs.

The chart represents the pass rate for each PSI and the Alberta Provincial HCA Exam average. Where the numbers of writers are low, it is important to consider the number of writers from each educational institution. Examinations with few or no writers will show larger average fluctuations compared to provincial averages.
